Provides low-income families with the financial resources; provides parents with a broad range of options in addressing their childcare needs, including center-based care, group home care, family home care, in-home relative care, and sectarian care; strengthens the role of the family; increases the availability of early childhood development programs and before/after school care services. The child care centers offer services to children from ages 4 months to 13 years of age; the ages vary by tribal child care centers. The centers are opened from 7:30 am to 5:30 pm, Monday to Friday. Short-term services are available, based on availability of space. The Centers promote learning and development in the following areas: social, emotional, physical, languages and cognitive in a healthy and safe environment. The children are also provided nutritious meals and snacks. Should an individual choose the tribal child care centers, the following child care centers are available. They are:

NAVAJO NATION SOCIAL SERVICES PROMOTES SAFE AND STABLE FAMILY PROGRAMS:

FAMILY PRESERVATION-- Services for families who have experienced out of the home placement through foster placement or a childcare institution; individual, group and family counseling; referrals to other departments for mental health services, domestic violence and inpatient, residential or outpatient substance abuse treatment services; in-home parenting; traditional teaching.

TIME LIMITED REUNIFICATION-- Services for families with children who are at risk for experiencing out of the home placement or returned shortly (72 hours) after out of the home placement.

BLOCK GRANTS AND SPECIAL PROJECTS DEPARTMENT-- Electricity assistance, propane and natural gas assistance, weatherization, basic needs, housing related, employment assistance, training, and education.
