Three COVID-19 vaccines are currently available across Indian Country: Pfizer, Moderna, and Johnson & Johnson. These vaccines are safe and effective tools for keeping our communities safe from COVID-19.

The Johnson & Johnson vaccine is 100% effective at preventing death and hospital visits from COVID-19 – the same as the Pfizer and Moderna vaccines – and it only requires one shot to be fully vaccinated. People who get the Johnson & Johnson vaccine can still develop mild symptoms of COVID-19.

Not a single person — including any Native American or indigenous person – died or was hospitalized from COVID-19 after receiving the Johnson & Johnson vaccine in a clinical trial.

COVID-19 vaccines are life-saving tools for our communities. These vaccines – along with continuing to wear masks, keep a safe distance, and wash our hands – are the best ways to protect our elders, our loved ones, and our communities.
